Topic: Review of Australia's Rio Olympic Performance

Question:

- a) Could you please detail who specifically is involved in conducting the review?
- b) What is the scope of the review?
- c) When will it be complete?
- d) What process(es) will the findings feed into?
- e) Will the findings be made public and if so, what will be the timeline and process for that occurring?

Answer:

- a) The Australian Institute of Sport (AIS) is supporting a review of Australia's Rio Olympic Performance that is being led by the Australian Olympic Committee (AOC). This review was planned pre-Rio with team members engaged prior to the Games, as well as in the post-Games period.
- b) The review engaged with all members of the Australian Olympic Team – athletes, coaches, service providers and team leaders. The review considered a variety of facets related to the planning and preparation of the Team leading into Rio as well as implementation during the Games period.
- c) The review was completed at the end of September 2016.
- d) The findings will feed into an AOC/AIS briefing forum involving representatives from Olympic sports and the Australian Olympic Team. This Forum is being held on 8 November 2016.
- e) The public release of the review's findings is a matter for the AOC to consider.
