Question:

a) Over the 10 years to 30 June 2016, how many ACFI claims have been downgraded through the validation process each year and in each state/territory?

- b) How many of these downgrades have been appealed and what percentage of these appeals were successful?
- c) What was the value over all of these successful appeals?

Answer:

a) Since the Aged Care Funding Instrument (ACFI) was introduced in 2008, the number of ACFI review downgrades has been:

- b) Approved providers requested ACFI review reconsiderations for 1,620 of these downgrades and 45 per cent of these reconsiderations resulted in the ACFI claim returning to the approved provider's classification decision.
- c) The administrative burden of calculating the overall value of the ACFI review reconsiderations that returned to the approved provider's classification decision would be very significant. Undertaking this task would require interrogation of systems to conduct an historical recount of ACFI subsidy changes from 728 reconsideration outcomes over the eight years the ACFI has operated, including changes in ACFI subsidy rates and appraisals over time.
