i) Adelphi Digital Consulting Group Pty Ltd: Declaration of interest was not included in original contract (signed in 2011–2012).

Linda R Scott & Associates Pty Ltd: Declaration of interest was not sought as on retainer for set services at set rate. Service provider selected due to previous experience.

Sapere Research Group Limited: This represents an extension of work. Declaration of interest was part of tender response in 2014–15. Face 2 Face Recruitment: Provider did not provide a declaration in their contracts with the two contractors involved. One contractor was a former FSANZ officer. The other had previously worked with FSANZ under Sensory 7 (included in table above) where a declaration had been provided.
