### **Question:**

What is the average annual salary of nurses in Australian public hospitals? Please provide a national average as well as state and territory averages

#### Answer:

In 2014–15, the average annual salary for nurses in Australian public hospitals was \$93,909. The following table shows the average salaries for full-time equivalent nurses for each state and territory in Australia in 2014–15.

Table 1: Average salaries for nurses (full-time equivalent staff) (\$), public hospital services, states and territories, 2014–15
