Senator Xenophon asked:

In the previous estimates hearings, I also asked about the funding for local content [in News] and was provided with detail about the allocation for South Australia.

1. How does the allocation for South Australia compare with the rest of the country? Can you provide me with a breakdown of funding across the other State and Territories?

Answer:

The allocation of funding for South Australia is comparable to that allocated around the country. The table below indicates the new positions created by the News Division across the country to support local content.
