Senator Urquhart, Anne asked:

Senator URQUHART: Somewhere around January or February.

Mr Robinson: I believe so, but I should take it on notice. **Senator URQUHART:** I thought it was December 2013.

Mr Clarke: Could you state again the question?

Senator URQUHART: When did the minister announce that he would form a panel of experts to do a review into the regulatory arrangements surrounding the NBN, including new developments? **Mr Robinson:** I think I should correct my answer. I meant the first part of 2014. It was an election commitment of the new government to undertake a review of regulatory arrangements and, of course, they were elected in September 2013. The announcement I will take on notice, but

I believe it was early in 2014.

Answer:

The Minister appointed a panel of experts to undertake a review of the regulatory arrangements for the National Broadband Network on 12 December 2013.

The panel commenced its review work with the release of a Regulatory Issues Framing Paper on 13 February 2014. The paper is available at:
