## Answer:

As at 31 April 2015 there were 140.1 (Full Time Equivalent) staff engaged in assessment, investigation, compliance and enforcement, and the Department will continue to maintain capabilities across the function of environmental assessments and approvals. All these staff remain available to consider, investigate and, where necessary, assess any action(s) that come to the department's attention and may be likely to have an impact on nationally protected matters.
