Senator Anne Urquhart asked:

Ms Lane: As of the end of March, approximately 1,400 participants have been engaged in Green Army projects. **Senator URQUHART:** Do you have a breakdown of where they are?

Ms Lane: I could take that on notice.

Answer:

As at 31 March 2015, 155 projects had commenced across Australia (Table 1).

Each project is comprised of one Team Supervisor and nine Participants.

Some teams have more than nine Participants total (where a Participant has left and is replaced) and some have fewer (for example in remote locations and where agreed by the Department teams may be comprised of less than nine Participants should there not be the number of unemployed youth available or willing).
