Senator Waters asked:

Mr Kennedy:I can make some remarks about where we expect the initial interest in particular to be in the auction. Ms Munro may follow this up later. Of course, there are a number of CFI projects transitioning across to the ERF arrangements, many with seven-year crediting periods in front of them. This will be an opportunity for them to secure value for those emissions reductions that they would get credited under these arrangements. There is actually considerable interest around those—

Senator WATERS: Sure, that is because CFI has been around quite—

Mr Kennedy: projects. We have had quite a bit of interest. Perhaps the best way to do this is by giving you—I do not have in front of me but through question on notice—the people who have been part of our technical working groups, but quite a bit of interest across all our technical working groups for developing methods. We would expect projects to come forward out of that process.
