- 5. Have there been any changes to the policies/criteria that govern the appointment of contract staff?

Answer:

- 1. The ABC does not differentiate between amounts paid to agencies/companies to find temporary/contract staff as opposed to permanent staff, nor is it feasible to determine these costs specifically from 14 September 2015.
