Senator Ludwig, Joe asked:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1. Has electronic equipment (such as ipad, laptop, wireless card, vasco token, blackberry, mobile phone (list type if relevant), thumb drive, video cameras) been provided by the department/agency to departmental staff? If yes provide a list of:
- 2. What has been provided?
- 3. The purchase cost.
- 4. The ongoing cost.
- 5. A list of any accessories provided for the equipment and the cost of those accessories. (e.g. iPad keyboards, laptop carry bags, additional chargers etc).
- 6. A breakdown of what staff and staff classification receives each item.

Answer:

- 1. Creative Partnerships has provided electronic equipment to staff since 14 September.
- 2. A MacBook Air laptop was provided to a staff member
- 3. The purchase cost of the laptop was \$1394
- 4. There is no ongoing cost associated with the laptop
- 5. No accessories were provided with the laptop
- 6. The laptop was purchased for the use of a member of the Executive team; Creative Partnerships does not employ staff under the Public Service Act and therefore the staff members does not have a classification.
