Senator Ludwig, Joe asked:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1. Has the Department / Agency given out awards to staff for any reason? If yes:

 - (c) What form did the award take? (e.g. Certificate, gift vouchers etc)

Answer:

1. Yes, nbn has a recognition program for staff that was introduced to support nbn's strategic goal to be a Great Place to Work.

- (a) Managers can provide awards (within an allocated budget) in the form of points to staff who receive recognition.
- (b) Awards are provided when recognition aligns to values and behaviours which have a positive business impact.
- (c) Basic recognition (peer-to-peer) is celebrated through a public recognition portal for all staff to see. Any awards allocated by managers take the form of 'points' which can be converted to items through a product catalogue. For great achievements, Quarterly Awards are selected by the senior leaders of the organisation where winners are invited to attend a celebration event.
- (d) \$58,500 has been spent on awards since 14 September 2015 to 29 February 2016.

2 & 3. Manager and Quarterly Awards are presented by line managers through the recognition portal.
