Senator Ludwig, Joe asked:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September 2015:

- 1. How many requests for documents under the FOI Act have been received?
- 2. Of these, how many documents have been determined to be deliberative documents?
- 3. Of those assessed as deliberative documents:
 - (a) For how many has access to the document been refused on the basis that it would be contrary to the public interest?
 - (b) For how many has a redacted document been provided?

Answer:

The following answers relate to the period from 14 September 2015 to 19 February 2016:

- 1. 17
- 2. Of the 17 requests, one request included a finding that one or more documents contained deliberative matter and were exempt under s47C of the *Freedom of Information Act 1982*. Five documents and part of one document were determined to be exempt under s47C.
- 3. (a) Five documents and part of one document
