Senator Ludwig asked:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1. How many requests for documents under the FOI Act have been received?
- 2. Of these, how many documents have been determined to be deliberative documents?
- 3. Of those assessed as deliberative documents:
 - a) For how many has access to the document been refused on the basis that it would be contrary to the public interest?
 - b) For how many has a redacted document been provided?

Answer:

- 1. In the period from 14 September 2015 to 19 February 2016, the Department of the Environment received 42 FOI requests.
- 2. Of the 320 documents which the Department has released in relation to these requests, the Department decided that 11 documents in two separate FOI requests contained deliberative content.
- 3. Out of the 11 documents decided to contain deliberative content;
 - a) Access to four documents was refused in full on the basis that release would be contrary to the public interest; and
 - b) Seven documents were released with the deliberative content redacted.
