**Senator Urquhart asked:**

Mr Oxley was unable to say in October whether all submissions on the draft TWWHA management plan had been made public. Can you now advise if that's the case?

**Answer:**

The Tasmanian Wilderness World Heritage Area (TWWHA) Management Plan is a matter for the Tasmanian Government.

The Tasmanian Government has advised that, as of 10 March 2016, the submissions on the draft Tasmanian Wilderness World Heritage Area (TWWHA) Management Plan had not been made public.

The Tasmanian Planning Commission, as soon as practicable after receiving copies of the submissions on the draft Management Plan from the Tasmanian Director of National Parks and Wildlife, is to notify by public notice:

- a) the places at which copies of the submissions are to be exhibited; and
- b) the period during which they are to be exhibited; and
- c) any other information the Commission considers relevant.
