## Senator Ludlam asked:

**Senator LUDLAM:** What do you think are the best channels for the public to find out the outcome of that investigation?

Dr de Brouwer: That would be a matter for taking up with the Northern Territory government,

Senator.

**Senator LUDLAM:** It has been nearly 2½ years since the incident. This might be more appropriate through you, Senator Birmingham: have you taken any steps to ask the NT government to expedite the release of that investigation?

Senator Birmingham: I will have to take that on notice.

## Answer:

The release of the Northern Territory Department of Mines and Energy investigation report into the 2013 Ranger mine leach tank incident is a matter for the Northern Territory government. The Australian Government has not requested the Northern Territory government to publicly release the report. The Northern Territory government has now made a public statement on 12 February 2016 on the outcome of its investigation into the failure of the leach tank at Ranger mine.
