## **Senator Rice asked:**

Has the Department of Environment or Minister asked the NSW Environment Department, Forestry Corporation (or anyone else in the NSW Government) to take action that reflects the change of status of the Greater Glider from common to threatened?

## Answer:

The Department is currently developing a draft Recovery Plan for the Greater Glider. A workshop was held in November 2016 to outline management and research actions that would assist in the recovery of the species.

The workshop included researchers and representatives from the Department of Agriculture and Water Resources, the NSW Government, the forestry industry and Non-Government Organisations.
