Senator Roberts asked:

Senator ROBERTS: My understanding is that the introduction of the automatic weather stations and small screens is a major time-synchronous change in the bureau's network. Bias resulting from synchronous changes cannot be detected by differencing one dataset with another—for example, Kent Town with Adelaide Airport; Sydney Observatory and Sydney Airport. Why does the bureau use differencing to investigate data inhomogeneity? Dr Johnson: I am not in a position in this hearing, here today, to comment on individual weather stations or individual sites. Again, if you have specific feedback, I would be happy to take that on notice.

Automatic weather stations were not synchronously introduced to the national network.
