Please provide an update on progress with the development of the Tentative Listing proposal World Heritage Listing for the Royal Reserves (Royal and Heathcote National Parks and Garawarra State Conservation Area)?

Answer:

The New South Wales Government is responsible for conducting the necessary work to demonstrate a credible case for any World Heritage nomination of Royal National Park and Reserves, and whether it is likely to reach the threshold for Outstanding Universal Value. The New South Wales Government has not yet developed a submission for Royal National Park and Reserves to be included on Australia's World Heritage Tentative List.
