Senator Siewert asked:

How does this intersect with the exchange Mr David Lindner boasts of in an ABC news story from 22 December 2016 where diesel or money for diesel is traded for the opportunity to hunt buffalo and other animals within the Buffalo Farm area?

Answer:

The Northern Land Council is responsible for ensuring that activities connected with the Buffalo Farm are carried out in accordance with the conditions of the approval issued by the then Director of National Parks in 1999. The conditions of that approval do not provide for the farm manager to allow hunting of buffalo or other animals in the area for commercial exchange. I have asked the Northern Land Council to provide advice on current and future management arrangements for the Buffalo Farm.
