**Senator Whish-Wilson asked:**

Has the Tasmania Government reported to the Department the outcomes of monitoring progress against the Captive Management Plan? When will the next report be completed? Will this report be made public?

**Answer:**

The Captive Management Plan (CMP) provides guidance on how breeding institutions collectively manage the captive orange-bellied parrot breeding population. The CMP does not require specific reporting from the breeding institutions to the Australian Government. The CMP was authored by the Captive Management Group. The Captive Management Group is a sub-group of the Recovery Team.
