Answer:

The following details relate to Australia Post (excludes subsidiaries):

- 1. 189 Permanent staff were recruited. Australia Post does not use Australian Public Service classifications. Classifications are determined as per the current Australia Post Enterprise Bargaining Agreement.
- 2. 67 Fixed Term Positions were created. Australia Post does not use Australian Public Service classifications. Classifications are determined as per the current Australia Post Enterprise Bargaining Agreement.
- 3. 59 staff were employed on contract and their average length of employment is three months.
