Senator Conroy: Thank you, Chair. As I said, I am assuming it is a legal requirement of the United States that the president, the board and the CEO of a company sign off on its annual budget.

Mr Morrow: I think that is a fair assumption to make.

Senator Conroy: Which would mean that you would have signed off on the 2008 budget, unless you broke the corporate law, which I am not for a moment alleging.

Mr Morrow: Again, I will not comment on anything to do during that period of time with that case.

Senator Conroy: Senator Fifield, did the minister seek any further information about the issues that Mr Morrow raised? I appreciate it if you take that on notice. I am happy for you to take it on notice.

Senator Fifield: Sure. I will take that on notice.

Answer:
