Topic: Workplace assessments

Senator Ludwig asked:

- 1. How much has been spent on workplace ergonomic assessments since 7 September 2013? List each item of expenditure and cost.
- 2. Have any assessments, not related to an existing disability, resulted in changes to workplace equipment or set up?
- 3. If so, list each item of expenditure and cost related to those changes.

Answer:

1. For the period prior to 1 February 2014, refer to answer to Question on Notice 390 for the Additional Estimates Hearings February 2014. From 1 February 2014 to 30 April 2014, a total of \$991.65 (GST excl) has been spent on workplace ergonomic assessments. The details of those costs are as follows:
