## **Topic: Communications Staff**

## Senator Ludwig asked:

For all Departments and Agencies, please provide – in relation to all public relations, communications and media staff – the following:

- 1. How many ongoing staff, the classification, the type of work they undertake and their location.
- 2. How many non-ongoing staff, their classification, type of work they undertake and their location
- 3. How many contractors, their classification, type of work they undertake and their location
- 4. How many are graphic designers?
- 5. How many are media managers?
- 6. How many organise events?

## Answer:

As at 30 April 2014, there were:

- Fourteen ongoing staff in the Department engaged in public relations, communications and media. Classifications: 2 EL2 Public Affairs Managers; 7 EL1 Public Affairs; 3 APS6 Communications Advisers; and 2 APS5 Communications Advisers. Two ongoing EL1 Public Affairs and 1 APS5 Communications Adviser based in Sydney, with remaining staff based in Canberra.
- 2. Two non-ongoing staff engaged in public relations, communications and media. One EL2 Public Affairs Manager and 1 APS6 Communications Adviser, both based in Canberra.
- 3. No contractors were employed by the Department at 30 April 2014.
- 4. Two staff were graphic designers.
- 5. One staff member was a media manager.
- 6. Five staff in the Media team (1 non-ongoing FTE and 4 ongoing FTE) assisted in coordinating events with other areas of the Department as at 30 April 2014.
