Please provide any/all information on the potential joint steering committee with NSW state government agencies and local stakeholders in relation to the Cumberland Conservation Corridor and potential cross-overs between the Green Army, 20 Million Trees, the Cumberland Conservation Corridor commitment and any other programs that may be involved.

Answer:

The Department has met with relevant NSW state government agencies and local stakeholders in relation to the Cumberland Conservation Corridor election commitments (including land acquisition/covenanted, Green Army and 20 Million Trees). A reference group will be formed from this stakeholder group. The Department will consult with the reference group at relevant stages of the project.
