Senator Ludwig asked:

1. How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers / Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio from Additional Estimates in February, 2014 to date?
 - a) Detail the items provided to the minister's office.
2. How much was spent on departmental stationery requirements from the Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date.

Answer:

1. Nil for portfolio agencies. The Department managed the costs for stationery requirements for the period 1 February 2014 to 30 April 2014 as outlined below.

Stationery requirements	\$ Cost (incl GST)
Minister Hunt	2,138
Parliamentary Secretary Birmingham	527

- a) Stationery items included pens, markers, folders, document trays, dividers, copier paper, envelopes, business cards, and 'With Compliments' slips.
2. From Supplementary Estimates in November 2013 to 30 April 2014, the Department of the Environment spent \$121,919 (including GST) on stationery requirements.
