Senator Ludwig asked:

How many documents (include the amount of copies) have been printed from Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date? How many of these printed documents were also published online?

Answer:

The Department

For the purpose of this response, a 'document' is defined as a book, booklet, brochure, guide, flyer, or factsheet.

Forty-two documents have been printed since the Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to 31 May 2014, with print quantities ranging from 10 to 60,000. Twenty-nine of the 42 documents had a printing quantity of 500 or less.

The Department uses a print management system to manage Panel and Multi-User List arrangements which tracks and reports all communication product activity including the volume of print material produced.

All of the Department's public documents are published online, excluding stationery items such as business cards or promotional materials such as banners.

The Department (Darwin/Jabiru):

One document has been printed since the Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to 31 May 2014, with a print quantity of 50.

This document was published online.

Bureau of Meteorology

Seventeen documents have been published since the Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to 31 May 2014. A total of 5150 copies were printed.

Of the 17 documents printed, 15 publications were published online.

Clean Energy Regulator

Four documents (with a total of 1,950 copies) were printed for the period 1 November 2013 to 31 May 2014.

Three of these documents were also published online.

Climate Change Authority

Two documents have been published since the Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to 31 May 2014, with quantities of 100 and 450.

Both documents were also published online and are available on the Authority's website.

Director of National Parks

Thirteen documents have been published since the Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to 31 May 2014. A total of 59,213 copies were printed.

Below is a breakdown of the print quantities:

- One had a print quantity of 3.
- One had a print quantity of 20,000
- One had a print quantity of 10
- One had a print quantity of 200
- One had a print quantity of 35,000
- Eight had a print quantity of 500

The Director of National Parks regularly produces park brochures and guides as core communication vehicles to inform and educate park visitors on a range of natural and cultural values, walks, safety and recreational opportunities in the parks.

Twelve of these documents were also published online

Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority

Two documents have been published since the Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to 31 May 2014, with quantities of 100 and 20,000.

Both of these documents have been published online.

Murray-Darling Basin Authority

Two documents have been printed since the Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to 31 May 2014, with quantities of 60 and 10,000.

Both documents are available on the Murray-Darling Basin Authority's website.

National Water Commission

No products were printed during the reporting period.

Sydney Harbour Federation Trust

Seven documents have been published since the Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to 31 May 2014, with quantities ranging from 1,000 – 10,000.

Two of these documents have been published online.
