Senator Urguhart, Anne asked:

- 1. I understand a tender for the Smithton mail run in Tasmania has recently been awarded. Is this correct?
- 2. How many tenders were received?
- 3. What processes does Australia Post have to keep applicants updated on the status of their tender?
- 4. Does the successful tenderer hold other mail contracts? If so, how many and where?
- 5. Who was awarded this tender?
- 6. Aside from price, what other factors were considered when comparing the tenders?
- 7. Is preference given to applications from local operators in the tender process?

Answer:

- 1. Yes.
- 2. Seven.
- 3. Australia Post does not provide status updates during the tender process. Successful and unsuccessful tenderers are notified on the same day.
- 4. Yes, they hold approximately forty contracts across Australia.
- 5. Aus-Lanka Express Pty Ltd.
- 6. In assessing a tender we review their costs, proposed operational, contingency, safety plans and any relevant prior work history. Each tender is then assessed against a selection criteria which includes the cost and capability of each tenderer. Based on this assessment, tenderers are then shortlisted and selected for interview.
- 7. No, once the mail contract goes to public tender it is bound by the terms and conditions of the tender process.
