**Senator Dastyari, Sam asked:**

As part of the Radiocommunications Assignment and Licensing Instruction—RALI, I think, is its abbreviation—has ACMA agreed to any conditions that require any licences issued to NBN Co in this band to be modified, should the spectrum band be restructured in the future?

**Mr Tanner:** Have we built into the RALI any requirement that the licences be modified in the event of a reconfiguration?

**Senator DASTYARI:** Yes.

**Mr Tanner:** We are not sure. I will have to take that question on notice.

**Senator DASTYARI:** Take that on notice.

The following text is provided in section 4.3 of RALI MS39:

**Advisory note C11** must be attached to all licences authorising PTS licences issued in the 3.5 GHz band:

*The 3400-3600 MHz band may be subject to re-planning in the future. This may require licensees to retune radiocommunication devices at their own cost.*
