Senator WATERS: If you could provide a list of the total funding and the full-time equivalents allocated to the relevant departmental section responsible for assessments, approvals and compliance monitoring under the EPBC Act—obviously the names will have changed—again, since 2008-09. Thank you.

Answer:

The table below provides an overview of FTE and expenses incurred for the Environmental Assessment and Compliance Division (EACD) since 2011/12, noting this division was first incepted on 23 June 2011.

EACD typically manages a range of business processes associated with the administration of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act (1999)* (EPBC Act) and the *Environment Protection (Sea Dumping) Act 1981*. The figures in Table 1 below are inclusive of the full range of work of the Division, including:

- Strategic assessments, regional sustainability planning, environment assessment and approvals, sea dumping (permits)
- Compliance audits, compliance incident assessment and follow up actions, seizures, investigations of the EPBC Act and other legislation administered by the department
- Assisting the department with regulatory compliance activities for all legislation administered by the department.
- Regulatory reform activities under the EPBC Act (in late 2013 a Regulatory Reform
 Taskforce was established in EACD to focus on implementing the Government's agenda to
 deliver a One Stop Shop for approval bilateral agreements with willing the States and
 Territories)

Prior to 2011/12 the functions of assessments, approvals and compliance monitoring under the EPBC Act were dispersed differently across the Department. Extracting staffing/funding data under these previous organisational structures is complex and would require substantial resources, which were unavailable at the time of preparing this response.
