Senator Urquhart asked:

How many projects that have been funded primarily promise specific outcomes for threatened species, rather than merely reference threatened species as indirectly benefiting from a given project?

Answer:

Based on successful applications through Rounds 1 and 2 of the Green Army programme, the Australian Government has announced 157 projects that work to protect threatened species, and a further 97 projects that work to provide potential ancillary benefits to threatened species.
