Topic: Increase of VPR Senator Ruston asked:

CHAIR: The increase of the VPR from 60c to 70c—what did that deliver in terms of bottom line modelling on existing postage numbers? What is the net value of the increase?

Mr Fahour: It was only introduced at the beginning of April this year.

CHAIR: What would that increase deliver over 12 months?

Mr Fahour: I would like to take that on notice but I am just going to give you an estimate. We said at a previous estimates hearing that our projection was that it would lower our losses by around \$100 million. At a previous Senate estimates—I nearly got it right—I said it was about \$95 million.

Answer:

The full year impact of the increase to the Basic Postage Rate (BPR) is forecast to be approximately \$87m for the 2014/15 financial year.
