Answer:

The following details relate to Australia Post (excludes subsidiaries):

- 386 permanent staff were recruited between 01 June 2014 31 October 2014. Australia Post does not use APS classifications. Classifications are determined as per the Australia Post Enterprise Bargaining Agreement.
- 294 Fixed Term Positions were created between 01 June 2014 31 October 2014. Australia
 Post does not use APS classifications. Classifications are determined as per the Australia Post
 Enterprise Bargaining Agreement.
- 3. 84 staff were employed on contract between 01 June 2014 31 October 2014and their average length of employment is five months.
