2. How many cars are leased by each department/agency?

How far did each car travel during the specified period?

Answer

1. (i)-(iv) Nil.

2. 16 cars are leased.
 - 2(i) Sydney – 11; Melbourne – 3; Canberra – 2.
 - 2(ii) Broadcast operations.
 - 2(iii) Leased cars cost an average of **\$35.42** per day per car (based on 7 days per week). To provide a detailed breakdown for each vehicle would require an unreasonable diversion of resources.

Leased cars travel an average of **50km** per day per car (based on 7 days per week). To provide a detailed breakdown for each vehicle would require an unreasonable diversion of resources.
