Answer:

1 and 2. The ABC is party to the following enterprise agreements.

3. The ABC Enterprise Agreement and the ABC Retail Agreement are both midway through their periods of operation. Planning for the next agreements has not yet commenced.

The two ABC Senior Employment Agreements and the ABC Actor's Agreement have passed their nominal expiry dates, however these agreements remain in force with conditions kept current and with appropriate administrative review and update to rates and allowances. To date the parties to these agreements have agreed not to initiate bargaining on the basis that:

- the agreements would continue to apply to all covered employees in accordance with the Fair Work Act;
- there have not been any major terms identified that would require negotiations to be initiated;
- there are other competing priorities that have required the focus of the parties' time and efforts.
