## Senator Ludwig asked:

Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014:

- 1. How much did the department/agency spend on temporary or contract staff?
- 2. How many temporary or contract staff have been employed?
- 3. What is the total number of temporary or contract staff currently employed?
- 4. How much was paid for agencies/companies to find temporary/contract staff?
- 5. Have there been any changes to the policies/criteria that govern the appointment of contract staff?

#### **Answer:**

- 1. For the period 1 June 2014 to 30 November 2014 the ABC spent \$12.1 million on all temporary and contract staff.
- 2. Since the budget estimates in June 2014 a total of 125 new employees have been engaged on non-ongoing contracts. (data at 14 December 2014 excludes casuals)
- 3. The ABC currently employs 630 non-ongoing contract employees. (data at 14 December 2014 excludes casuals)
- 4. The ABC does not differentiate between amounts paid to agencies/companies to find temporary/contract staff as opposed to full-time staff. As a result, this information is not available.
- 5. Since the budget estimates in June 2014 there have been no changes to the policies/criteria that govern the appointment of contract staff.
