## **Topic: Communications staff**

## Senator Ludwig, Joe asked:

- 1. For all departments and agencies, please provide in relation to all public relations, communications and media staff the following:
- 2. How many ongoing staff, the classification, the type of work they undertake and their location.
- 3. How many non-ongoing staff, their classification, type of work they undertake and their location
- 4. How many contractors, their classification, type of work they undertake and their location
- 5. How many are graphic designers?
- 6. How many are media managers?
- 7. How many organise events?

## Answer:

As at 31 October 2014, there were:

- 1. Thirteen ongoing staff in the Department engaged in public relations, communications and media. Classifications: 2 EL2 Public Affairs Managers; 6 EL1 Public Affairs; 4 APS6 Communications Advisers; and 1 APS5 Communications Adviser. Two ongoing EL1 Public Affairs based in Sydney, with remaining staff based in Canberra.
- 2. Two non-ongoing staff engaged in public relations, communications and media. One EL2 Public Affairs Manager and 1 APS6 Communications Adviser, both based in Canberra.
- 3. Nil.
- 4. Two staff were graphic designers.
- 5. One staff member was a media manager.
- 6. 5.5 staff in the Media team (1 non-ongoing FTE and 4.5 ongoing FTE) assisted in coordinating events with other areas of the Department as at 31 October 2014.
