- 8. Departmental officers travel domestically for a variety of reasons. Travel records do not allow the Department to determine with accuracy which travel was to accompany the Minister and/or Parliamentary Secretary. With regard to international travel, no departmental officers have accompanied the Minister and/or Parliamentary Secretary on any overseas trip for the period 1 May 2014 to 31 October 2014.
- 9. For the period 1 May 2014 to 31 October 2014, the total expense for departmental officers was \$0.544m (GST excl) for domestic travel and \$0.222m (GST excl) for international travel.
