## **Senator Waters asked:**

Can the department outline what analysis it has done of the various state and territory policies for the protection of matters of national environmental significance - in particular it would be useful to understand if Department has done any analysis on state approaches to offsets given the recent senate inquiry?

## Answer:

The relevant aspects of state and territory environmental assessment and approval processes have been analysed, including environmental offsets for matters of national environmental significance. State environmental offsets policies and/or methodologies for calculating offsets have been analysed for consistency with the EPBC Act Environmental Offsets Policy.
