## Senator Urquhart asked:

**Senator URQUHART**: Okay, we will deal with those at 4.45. I just have one on the carbon tax repeal. The carbon tax has gone. Has your team reduced in numbers due to the repeal?

**Dr Kennedy**: The team that was responsible for repeal has disbanded.

**Senator URQUHART**: Were they part of your team? **Dr Kennedy**: They are part of Mr Parker's division.

**Senator URQUHART**: Which is? We would like on the record what that division is. **Ms Hoitink**: It is the climate change and renewable energy division. It was a task force

established for repeal and it has now disbanded. **Senator URQUHART**: What were the numbers?

**Ms Hoitink**: I do not think I have that to hand. I can take that on notice.

**Senator URQUHART**: Are you able to provide that?

**Ms Hoitink**: Yes, absolutely.

## Answer:

The carbon tax repeal task force was staffed over three distinct phases of work:

- 1. September-November 2013: Repeal decision, consultation and legislation preparation process 12 full-time equivalent officers, plus assistance from others as required.
- 2. November 2013-June 2014: Repeal process management 6 full-time equivalent officers, plus assistance from others as required.
- 3. June-July 2014: Repeal legislation passage 3 full-time equivalent officers, plus assistance from others as required.

The task force was disbanded immediately after passage of the main repeal Bill on 17 July 2014.
