## Answer:

Resourcing for the Department of the Environment and portfolio agencies since Budget Estimates in May 2014 is set out in the Government's budget papers, including the Environment Portfolio Budget Statements 2014-2015, Portfolio Additional Estimates Statements 2013-2014 and Portfolio Supplementary Additional Estimates Statements 2013-2014.

As indicated in these documents, additional departmental resourcing was received for the Green Army, Southern Ocean Flights, Asia-Pacific Rainforest Summit, National Climate Change Adaptation Research Facility, Antarctica – Maintaining Australia's Presence, Sustainable Rural Water Use and Infrastructure Programme and the Bureau of Meteorology replacement supercomputer measures.
