The Department and portfolio agencies are not required to seek approval from the Australian Public Service Commission (APSC) to engage an employee. From 1 October 2013 approval was required to advertise a position in *APS Jobs* but since 19 September 2014 this approval is no longer required if a position is to be advertised as being open only to APS employees.

However, the Clean Energy Regulator sought approval from the APSC in relation to the engagement of an ongoing SES Band 1, the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority sought approval from the APSC in relation to four engagements and the Murray-Darling Basin Authority sought approval from the APSC in relation to one engagement.
