Senator Ludwig asked:

Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014, how much has been spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers / Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio to date?

- a. Detail the items provided to the minister's office?
- b. Please specify how many reams of paper have been supplied to the Minister's office.
- c. How much has been spent on departmental stationery requirements to date.
- d. Has any customised stationery been requested or provided to the Minister or Ministerial Staff? If yes, please include a photo/scan, detail the type of stationery, date it was requested, date it was provided and the cost.

Answer:

The Department of the Environment manages stationery requirements and costs for its Minister and Parliamentary Secretary. The Department's portfolio agencies have a nil response.

For the period 1 May 2014 to 30 September expenditure was:
