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Topic: Central Coast – Southern End Service

Senator O'Neill, Deborah asked:

Senator O'NEILL: Thank you very much. I would appreciate that as promptly as you can. The other part of the Central Coast, down the southern end of the Central Coast: have you got any available for service there?

Mr Morrow: We will check on that as well.

Senator O'NEILL: Is that a yes or no?

Mr Morrow: We do not have it available at the moment but we will see if we can get it quickly.

Senator O'NEILL: The first comments that I made to you about 14 per cent failure were in that Gorokan region? Could you check that for me?

Mr Morrow: Yes.

Senator O'NEILL: And reports that it was higher down at the southern end, could you check that for me as well, seeing that you do not have the detail?

Mr Morrow: It is an area that we have already started to deploy in. We can. If we have not got it, it would be information with Telstra that we may not have. We will certainly check.

Answer:

The percentage of faults on active services that occurred in the Gorokan area up to 20 October was less than two per cent.
