Senator Urquhart asked:

Senator URQUHART: I want to get back to the crown-of-thorns starfish. How many crown-of-thorns starfish were destroyed lost financial year?

thorns starfish were destroyed last financial year?

**Dr Reichelt:** I can get you the figure in one second. I understand it is about 360,000.

Ms M Johnson: But that would be over a period of—

Dr Reichelt: Over the last 18 months.

**Senator URQUHART:** I am talking about the last financial year. Do you have that broken

down?

**Ms M Johnson**: I do not think that I have it broken down into years, no.

Mr Thompson: The department does not have that breakdown either. We have a number of

380,000 crown-of-thorns starfish killed to date through the various—

Senator URQUHART: 380,000?

**Mr Thompson:** Yes, through the whole program.

Ms M Johnson: Through the program.

Mr Thompson: Yes, it is 2012, 2013—

Senator URQUHART: Since 2012?

Mr Thompson: Yes.

Senator URQUHART: You do not do a yearly breakdown?

Ms M Johnson: We would have those numbers, but we just do not have them here.

**Senator URQUHART:** Are you able to get that information?

Ms M Johnson: Yes.

**Senator URQUHART:** By the end of today?

Ms M Johnson: Yes.

Answer:

1. During the 2014-2015 financial year the crown-of-thorns starfish control programme received \$5.05 million. This comprised \$2,000,000 in funding from Reef Programme; \$800,000 from Reef Trust 2, via the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority; and \$1,800,000 from Reef Trust 1, via the Reef and Rainforest Research Centre (RRRC) (Refer to Attachment A) The crown-of-thorns starfish control programme was also indirectly supported by Australian Government investment in research via \$450,000 of funding from Reef Programme and substantial in-kind support for surveillance from the Joint Field Management Program.

2. During the 2014-2015 financial year one vessel *MV Hero* was funded for the entire period. In addition, a second vessel, *MV Venus* was commissioned and managed by the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority for eight months. The *MV Venus* was managed for the remainder of the year by the Reef and Rainforest Research Centre under the Reef Trust 1 funding. The vessel(s) are typically crewed by 10 people — a skipper and mate and eight control divers — however this number varies dependent on whether research and surveillance activities are conducted concurrently with the culling work.
