**Senator Urquhart asked:**

1. Has there been an increase in the amount of E Waste being processed in the last quarter?
2. What impact does E Waste have on your resources?

**Answer:**

1. Yes. The National Television and Computer Recycling Scheme indicative reporting for Quarter 4 of 2014-15 is that approximately 11,633 tonnes of the annual target of 42 653 tonnes was recycled during this quarter. Recycling undertaken in Quarter 3 of 2014-15 was approximately 8,757 tonnes.
2. The National Television and Computer Recycling Scheme is currently staffed by approximately 4.6 FTE.
