**Senator Urquhart asked:**

**Senator URQUHART:** Can you provide to the committee projects that have been approved by the trust? I am happy for you to take that on notice.

**Mr Thompson:** We will need to take that on notice.

**Answer:**

The Sydney Harbour Federation Trust has approved and undertaken a number of projects relating to the 400 plus former Defence buildings on its sites. These include:

- Child Care Facility at Headland Park (Mosman) and North Head Sanctuary (Manly)
- Gymnasium at Headland Park and North Head Sanctuary
- Function Centres at Headland Park, North Head Sanctuary and Woolwich Dock
- Dance Studios at Headland Park
- Marine Science Institute at Headland Park
- Restaurants and cafes at Headland Park, North Head Sanctuary, Cockatoo Island and Woolwich Dock
- Boutique Offices at Headland Park and Cockatoo Island
- Artists' Precinct at Headland Park
- Cockatoo Island Camping and Holiday Accommodation
- Residential accommodation at Macquarie Lightstation, Headland Park and North Head Sanctuary
- Environmental education at North Head Sanctuary
- Plant Nursery at North Head Sanctuary

In addition to the projects approved and undertaken to buildings, projects have been approved to undertake works to the Harbour Trust's sites such as:

- Walking tracks
- Restoration and preservation of World Heritage site
- Bush regeneration
- Landscaping
- Establishment of car parks
