Senator Urquhart, Anne asked:

**Senator URQUHART**: Is it a coincidence that, of the 42 awareness forums, the two marginal coalition electorates had forums twice; whereas the 33 other electorates had no forums? Is that just a coincidence? How did that happen?

Senator Fifield: No-one at the table knows what the number of forums were or where they were held.

**Senator URQUHART**: I am telling you what they were. Did the department pay any costs of the forums?

Mr Paterson: Not to my knowledge, no. Senator URQUHART: No costs at all? Mr Paterson: I would not believe so.

Senator URQUHART: You would not believe so—you do not know for sure?

**Mr Paterson**: I was not in the job at the time, but I could take it on notice. I would be very

surprised if we paid any costs.

**Senator URQUHART**: Mr Robinson?

**Mr Robinson**: I would be very surprised as well, but we will take it on notice.

**Senator URQUHART**: Dr Smith? **Dr Smith**: We will take it on notice.
