# **Topic: Technology Choice**

## Senator Urquhart, Anne asked:

- 1. Please provide the number of premises currently making use of an NBN connection resulting from the Technology Choice Program?
  - (a) How many premises in total?
  - (b) Please break down premises by State and Territory.
  - (c) How many of these premises were from Area Switch?
  - (d) How many of these premises were from Individual Premises Switch?
- 2. Please provide figures for revenue received through Application Fees, Design and Quote fees and Build Payments that NBN Co has received from Technology Choice to date?
  - (a) Total revenue
  - (b) Revenue from area switch
  - (c) Revenue from individual premises switch
- 3. Please provide the average revenue (from Application Fees, Design and Quote fees and Build Payments) per premise from those who have taken up Technology Choice?

#### **Answer:**

As at 7 November 2016:

- 1. (a). 15
  - (b). NSW: 6, VIC: 1, QLD: 3, WA: 3, SA: 1, TAS: 1
  - (c). Area Switch: 0. There are currently two area switch sites under contract and in progress
  - (d). Individual Premises Switch: 15
- 2. (a). Total revenue recognised (based on invoices issued to date): \$654,040.
  - (b) Revenue recognised (invoices issued to date) from Area Switch: \$297,804.
  - (c) Revenue recognised (invoices issued to date) from Individual Premises Switch: \$356,236.
- 3. Average revenue per premise (based on completed individual premises switch sites) from those who have taken up Technology Choice: \$22,368 per premises.
